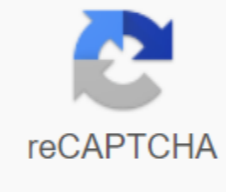

Mississippi's speed limit is as follows: 70 mph on interstates 65 mph on a 4-lane highway 55 mph on a 2-lane highway 50 mph on the Natchez Trace Parkway.What are the following distance rules that are good to follow? Use the 3-second rule when following other vehicles. When the vehicle in front of you passes a certain point, count: one-thousand, two-thousand, three-thousand, etc. If you pass the point before finishing counting, increase the following distance. Certain situations such as heavy traffic or poor conditions may require a longer following distance. How far before you had to use your turn signal? Turn signals must be given at least 100 feet before turning. When should you use your headlights in Mississippi? If weather conditions require the use of your windshield wipers, you should turn on your low-light headlights. Turning on your low-light headlights at any time prevents you from seeing other vehicles. Use your headlights on country roads or mountains, even when it's sunny. Use your headlights when visibility is less than 1,000 feet. Turn on the headlights from sunset to sunrise. When do you have to dim your high lights? Dim your high beam lights within 150 meters of an upcoming vehicle or when following within 150 meters behind another vehicle. What are some places where you are not allowed to park in Mississippi? Where there's a No Parking sign. At crossings, sidewalks, or in front of driveways. Block climbs for people with disabilities. In a tunnel or bridge, Allowed. Between the safe zone and the sidewalk. On the wrong side of the road. On the highway, unless it's an emergency or when directed to do so by a police officer. Within 10 feet of the hydrant. Within 20 feet of the entrance to the fire 20 foot crossing at the intersection. Within 10 feet of any traffic control device. It is 50 metres from the railway crossing.
